Attend mass (dozens on offer in almost every language in the world) somewhere in or around the holy sites. Long isolated and impoverished, Andorra achieved considerable prosperity through its tourist industry after World War II. Andorra also has duty free prices in tobacco. High cost items tend to be cheaper than anywhere else because of the low tax. We can admire the Cathedral of Santiago, the Plaza Nueva and the Basque Museum, On the other side of the bridge we find the Ensanche, a cosmopolitan and business district with many shops, bars and restaurants where you can taste the famous delicious Basque cuisine. It is also interesting a visit to the Market of the Ribera, an Art Deco style building where you can find the best food products in town. Dinner and accommodation.

DAY4: Bilbao-Santander-Santillana-Covadonga-Oviedo (320 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Santander. Arrival and free time. Santander is an elegant city located on a wide and beautiful bay with a wonderful view of the Cantabrian Sea. Its old town shows some stately buildings surrounded by an amazing sea and mountain natural environment. The city has an old marine and commercial tradition and many attractions such as the famous beach of El Sardinero, or the promenade along the peninsula of La Magdalena, that make it a perfect place for tourism. We will follow our trip to Santillana del Mar, a city declared National Monument. Located along the Camino of Santiago, Santillana de mar is a beautiful medieval town. In its cobbled medieval streets, we can also find many craftwork shops. Driving through beautiful landscapes we will arrive at Covadonga, gate of the National Park of Picos de Europa where we will have free time to visit the Sanctuary. The basilica was built next to the cave where the image of the Santina appeared, it is a place of worship and pilgrimage of all Asturians. It is a Neo-Romanesque building, with two towers at its the main entrance. Inside there are art works of great value, such as a canvas by Madrazo. Next we will continue to Oviedo. Dinner and accommodation.

DAY5: Oviedo-Salamanca-Madrid (531 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Salamanca A beautiful city of the Renaissance period with a famous university. Free time to walk through its old town cobble stone streets, and see its famous baroque Plaza Mayor one of the most beautiful in Europe. Day 01: Arrival Lisbon - Fatima

Arrival to airport of Lisbon. Meet and greet and transfer by private bus to Fatima (02 hours), check in the hotel. Fatima is a town and Parish located 142 km (88 miles) North of Lisbon. Fatima is one of the most important catholic shrines in the world dedicated to the Virgin Mary. Fatima's Sanctuary welcomes millions of people to make the pilgrimage every year to fulfill their promises, to pray and feel its mystical presence. Dinner and overnight night at the hotel.

Day 02: Fatima

Breakfast in the hotel. Full Day in Fatima, one of the most famous Catholic Sanctuaries. Fatima's fame is due to the Apparitions of Our Lady of the Rosary that appeared to three shepherd children: Lucia dos Santos and her two younger cousins, Francisco and Jacinta. Between May and October of 1917, the three children witnessed several apparitions. The last one, on October 13th, was confirmed by a miracle witnessed by 60,000 people known in the catholic world as "the day the sun danced". Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight in Fatima.

Day 03: Fatima-Oporto – Santiago compostela

Breakfast in the hotel and check out. Departure to Oporto. Is the second-largest city in Portugal, after Lisbon, and one of the major urban areas in Southwestern Europe. We will visit Porto's Cathedral (Sé do Porto), located in the historical centre of the city of Porto, is one of the city's oldest monuments and one of the most important Romanesque monuments in Portugal. The cathedral is flanked by two square towers, each supported with two buttresses and crowned with a cupola. The façade lacks decoration and is rather architecturally heterogeneous. It shows a Baroque porch and a beautiful Romanesque rose window under a creenellated arch, giving the impression of a fortified church.

Day 04: Santiago de Compostela

Breakfast in the hotel. After this, drive to Santiago Today we are going to spend the day in Santiago de Compostela capital of the autonomous community of Galicia in northwestern Spain. In the beginning of the 9th century, a hermit called Pelagius saw a mysterious light shining over a Roman tomb forgotten in the middle of a forest. Very soon, the incredible news spread all over the Christian world: the tomb of St. James the Greater, the beloved apostle of Jesus Christ, had been discovered in a far site near the Finis Terrae, the end of the known Earth, in the northwest of Iberian Peninsula. A few years later, this site became a famous pilgrimage town, one of the most important of Christianity. Pilgrims came from all over Europe following the Camino de Santiago to reach the city born around the Holy Tomb, exercising a great influence on the surrounding area. This is evidenced in the small towns, churches, hospitals, and monasteries that were built near the Camino to attend to the thousands of pilgrims who came to visit the tomb.

Day 05: Santiago de Compostela

Breakfast in the hotel, visit finesterre. Finisterre is situated mid-way between the "Rias Altas" and "Rias Baias" (upper and lower bays of Galicia) and is approximately one hour from La Coruna city and a similar driving duration from Santiago de Compostela. Both routes are scenic and take you through the Sierra de Santiago. If you drive to the top of the mountains shadowing the holiday town Muros (to the south), the Cape of Finisterre can be seen in the distance on a clear day. Return to Santiago, dinner and overnight.

PORTUGAL - SPAIN 2018

Day 06: Santiago de Compostela - Braga - Lisbon

Breakfast in the hotel and check out. Departure to Braga situated in the northwestern Portuguese district of Braga, in the historical and cultural Minho Province. The city was the European Youth Capital in 2012. Braga is a lively city, one of the oldest in the country, and is teeming with young people who study at its universities. Built more than 2,000 years ago, "Bracara Augusta" was, as the name indicates, founded by Augustus. It was located on one of the main Roman roads in the Iberian Peninsula, since it was the administrative seat of the Empire, and later given the status of capital of the Roman province of Gallaecia, present-day Galicia, by Emperor Caracalla. The Braga Diocese is the oldest in Portugal and, in the Middle Ages, the city even competed with Santiago de Compostela in power and importance. One of the Camiños de Santiago passed through here, when this pilgrimage cult grew with the Christian reconquest and the foundation of Portugal. We will visit The Cathedral of Braga (Portuguese: Sé de Braga) is one of the most important monuments in the city of Braga. Due to its long history and artistic significance it is also one of the most important buildings in the country.

Day 07 Lisbon

Breakfast in the hotel. Visit the main interresting places in Lisbon, the Jerónimos Monastery replaced the church formerly existing in the same place, which was dedicated to Santa Maria de Belém and where the monks of the military-religious Order of Christ provided assistance to seafarers in advantageous spot for mariners, with a safe anchorage and protection from the winds, sought after by ships entering the mouth of the Tagus. The existing structure was inaugurated on the orders of Manuel I (1469–1521) at the courts of Montemor o Velho in 1495, as a final resting-place for members of the House of Aviz, in his belief that an Iberian dynastic kingdom would rule after his death. In 1496, King Manuel petitioned the Holy See for permission to construct a monastery at the site.

Day 08: Lisbon - Airport

Breakfast in the hotel and check out and transfer to airport of Lisbon for your departure flight.

The little monastery soon began to receive pilgrims and visitors who contributed to the spread of stories of miracles and wonders performed by the Virgin. Today, Montserrat has been modernized to continue attending the pilgrim needs, one thousand years after it was originally founded.

You will be given some free time to visit the audio visual exhibition about the history and creation of Montserrat and to taste typical liquors of Montserrat. The Escolaria of Montserrat is one of the oldest boys' choirs in Europe (XIV Century).
